

Ambulatory Surgery Unit



Phelps County Regional Medical Center opened a new, state-of-the-art outpatient Ambulatory Surgery Unit (ASU) in 2007. The ASU is located on the second floor of the new Medical Office Building, which adjoins the main hospital. This ASU team is consistently above the 90th percentile nationwide as measured by Press Ganey patient satisfaction surveys (four months at the 99th percentile nationwide since September 2008). In 2009 the ASU was a Press Ganey national Success Story finalist.

Nurses in this area work closely together as a team to achieve these top outcomes, so when there is an opening (which is rare) only the best are considered. RNs are required to have at least one year RN experience, so new grads are not hires to this area. ACLS, BLS, and PALS are required.
