These busy units require nurses to have top-notch critical care skills and experience. A large variety of surgeries are done at PCRMC every day. Nurses in these areas have on-call obligations so must live with 45 minutes of the hospital.

ACLS, BLS and PALS are required. New graduate nurses are not hired to this area.
