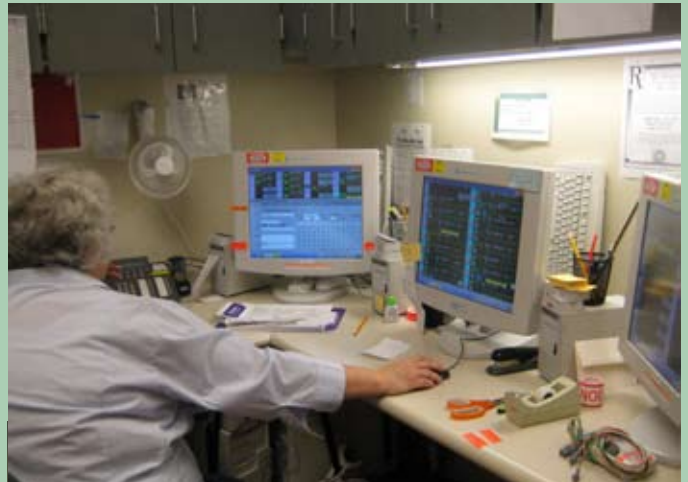


Medical Telemetry



The Medical Telemetry unit is a 26 bed unit, completely new in 2005. Medical Telemetry cares for the cardiac patients as well as all types of medical and surgical patients. All nurses have special training to work with cardiac patients, including ACLS, BLS, ECG classes, and cardiac care classes. There is a 5:1 patient to nurse ratio. Even though this is a fast-paced floor, graduate nurses are welcome here.

Each room has a "boom arm" technology that allows all the lines, drips, oxygen, plugs, etc to be centrally located for convenient use and movement. Medications for patients are located in locked cabinets in the nurse's computer cart for easy access. All charting, medication administration and ordering are electronic. Equipment is state of the art.
