

Medical Oncology



The Medical Oncology unit is a 38 bed unit, completely remodeled in 2007. Med-Onc cares for the cancer patients as well as all types of medical and surgical patients. After one year on the unit, nurses can be sent for chemo administration training to be able to administer chemo. There is also an outpatient infusion unit on the unit.

Medical Oncology works with a team approach with a 10:1 patient to team ratio. Each team consists of the RN, LPN and PCA. Med-Onc is a great floor for learning and graduate nurses are welcome here.

Medications for patients are located in locked cabinets in the nurse's computer cart for easy access. All charting, medication administration and ordering are electronic. Equipment is state of the art.
